

Health and Safety Policy Statement

It is the policy of Taylor Technology Systems Ltd (TTSL) to

- Provide safe and healthy working conditions for all employees and persons affected by our works
- Carry out their operations so far as is reasonably practicable to ensure that the Health, Safety and Wellbeing of any person or property will not be adversely affected by their undertakings.

TTSL will comply fully with the legal obligations placed upon it by the Health and Safety at Work (Etc.) Act 1974, all other Acts and Regulations, Network Rail Company and Railway Group standards, and relevant industry standards, in relation to the provision of rail and construction services to the private and public sectors, that involves electronic security systems, electrical, CCTV, construction work and related services. Legal compliance will be the minimum requirement, with continuous improvement in line with the standards.

This policy is linked to the Policies of the company and is implemented through the delivery of the company Health and Safety Management System at Company and Project level. All managers will ensure that the Health and Safety procedures contained in the company Health and Safety Management System are observed, and promote an awareness of health and safety with employees as an integral part of good management. This will be achieved in the management of health and safety through effective communication and consultation.

Performance shall be reviewed and monitored on a regular basis and measured against objectives set by the TTSL Directors. All findings will be communicated throughout the Company.

Monitoring the Health and Safety procedures and performance within the company is undertaken by project management aided and advised by the Company Quality Safety, Health & Environment Managers who report to the Directors and recommend changes where necessary.

This policy is made freely available to all interested parties including members of the general public.

TTSL shall review this policy and local arrangements periodically and take action if necessary to maintain compliance with Industry Standards and Best Practice
